

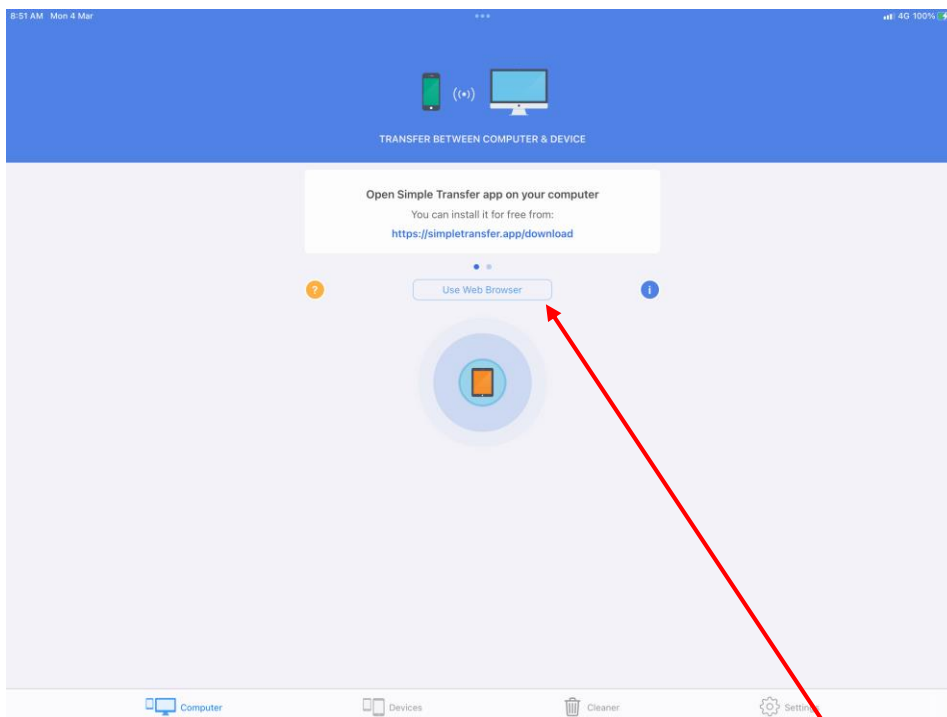

PHONE (OR IPAD) TO COMPUTER

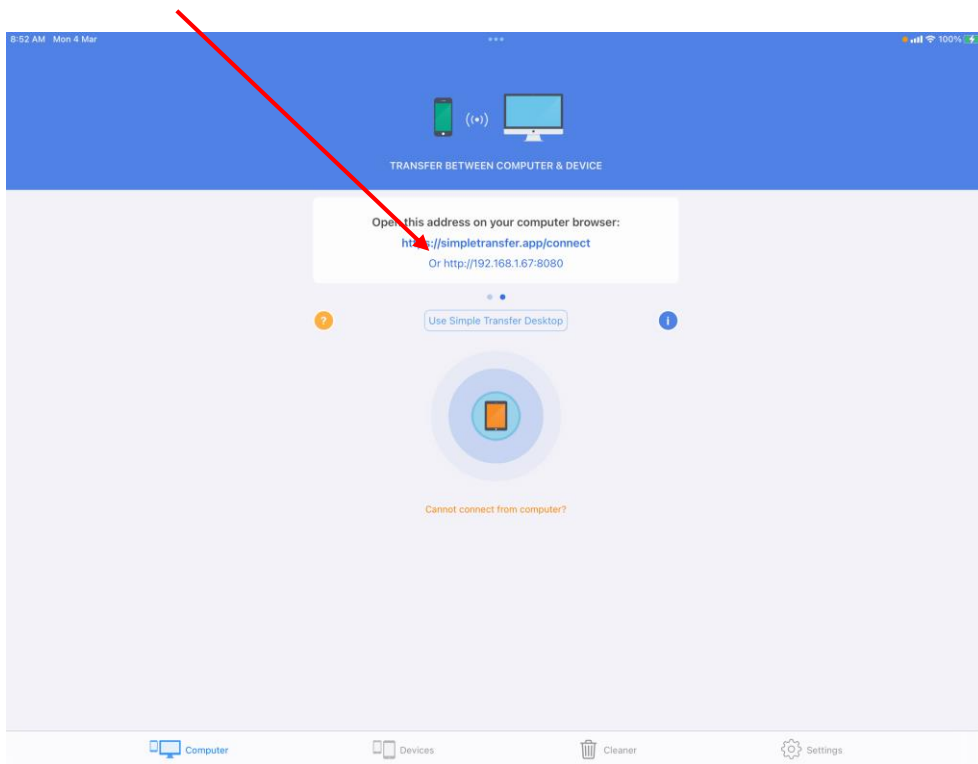
Method 1 (using an app)

- Install “SIMPLE TRANSFER” app on your phone/iPad
(see <https://apps.apple.com/us/app/simple-transfer-photo-video/id420821506>)
- Make sure that you are connected to the same router as your computer
([check your WI-FI connection in the settings app on your phone](#))
- On your phone (or iPad) launch the “Simple Transfer” App

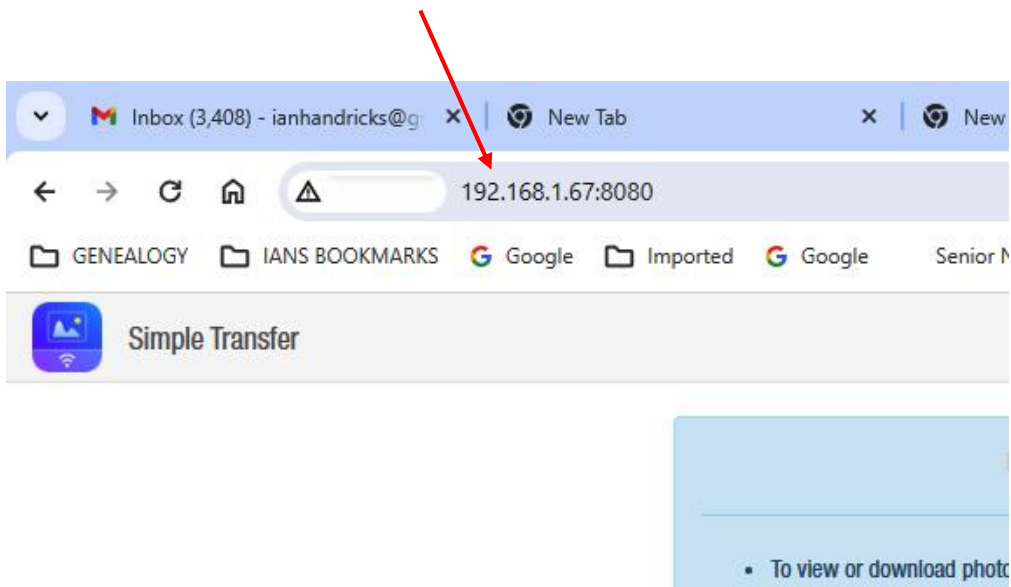


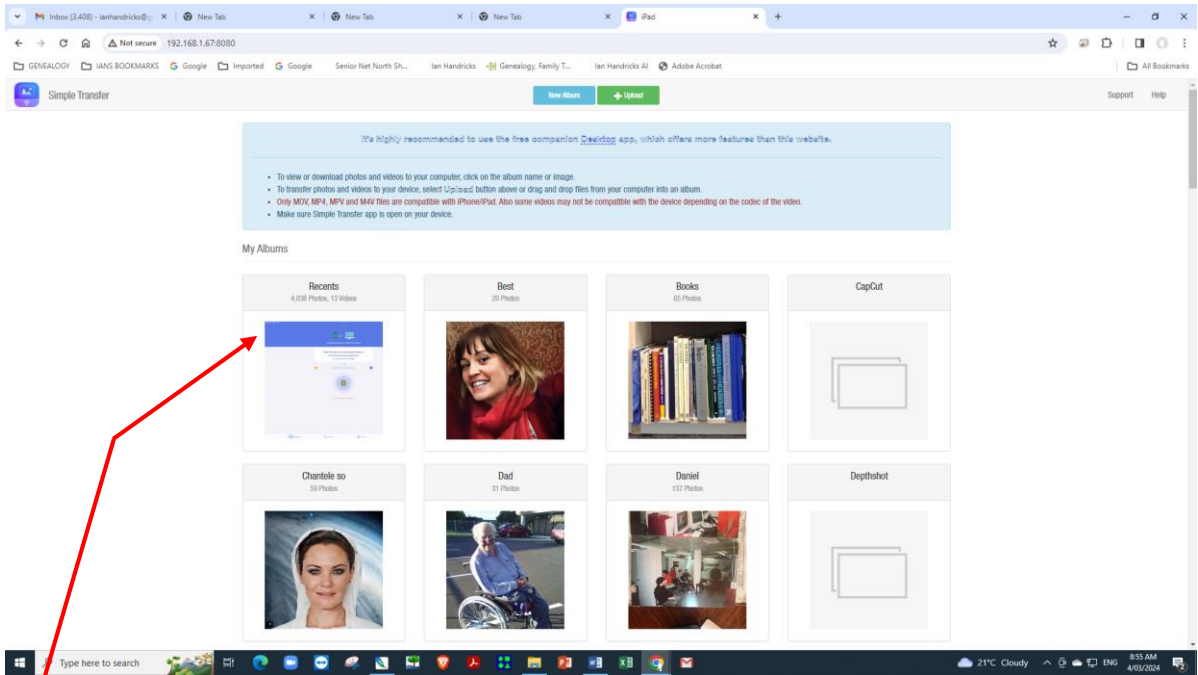
- In the middle of the screen you will see a button which says “USE WEB BROWSER”

- Click on that button – it will then display a http:// number sequence (e.g. <http://192.168.1.67:8080>)

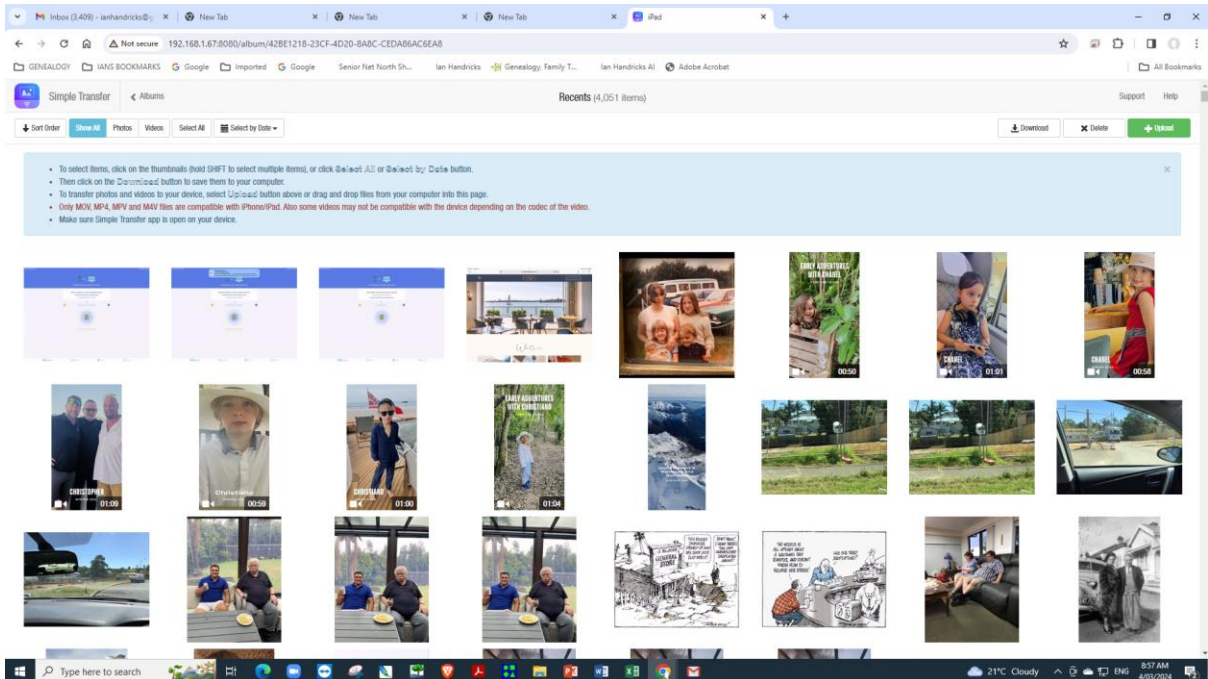


- Enter that number sequence (exactly) on your computer (or laptop) in the top URL line on your browser (e.g. Chrome) – make sure commas and colons are correct

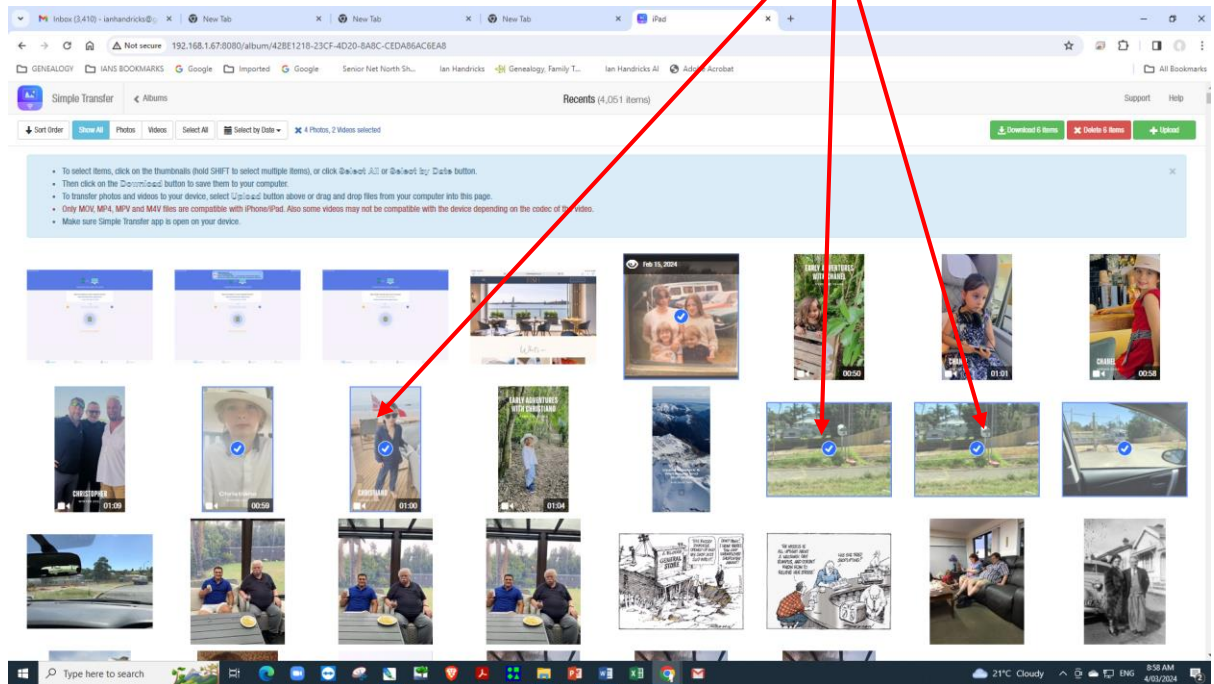




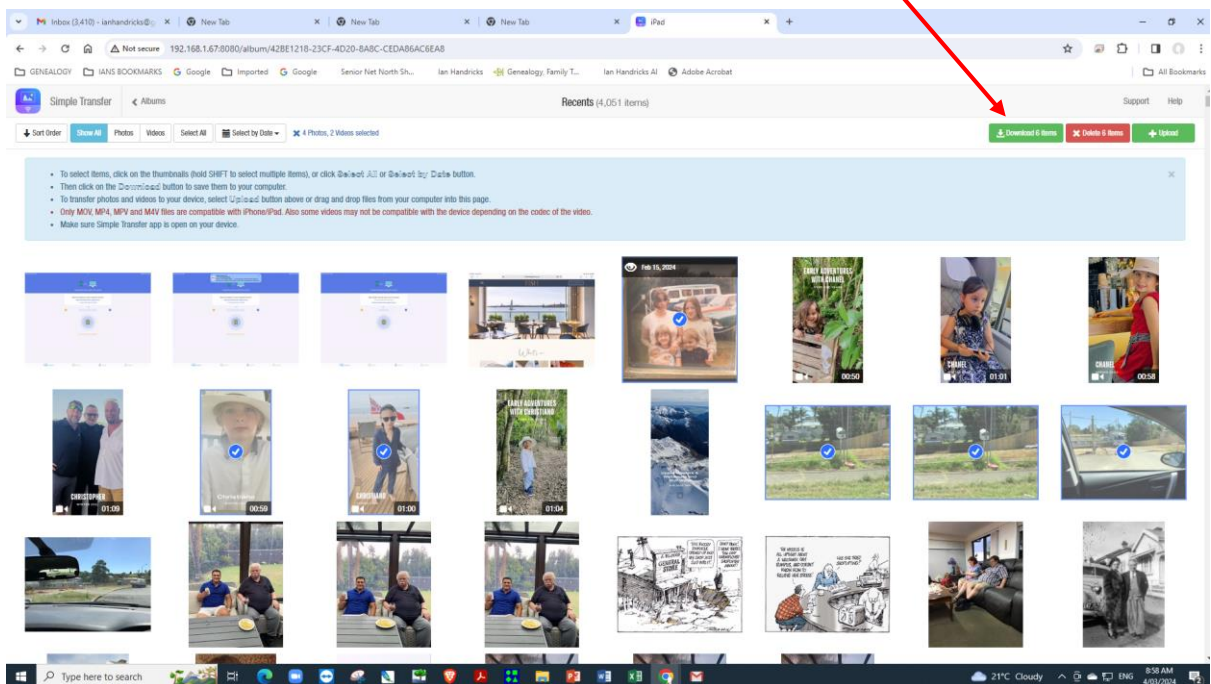
- The contents of your phone's photo library will appear on your PC
- All your phone's photos are stored in the "RECENTS" folder
- Click on "RECENTS" – that will display all of your photos



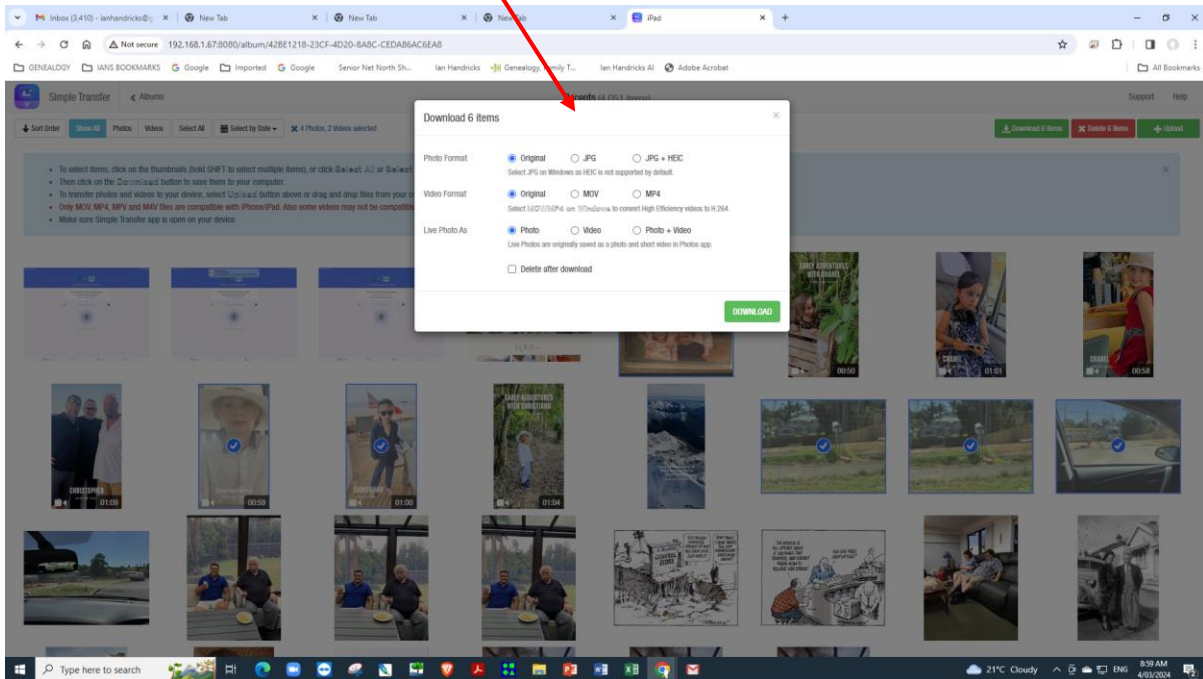
- Click on all the photos that you want to transfer (a blue tick will appear on each selected photo) – you can unselect by clicking the photo again



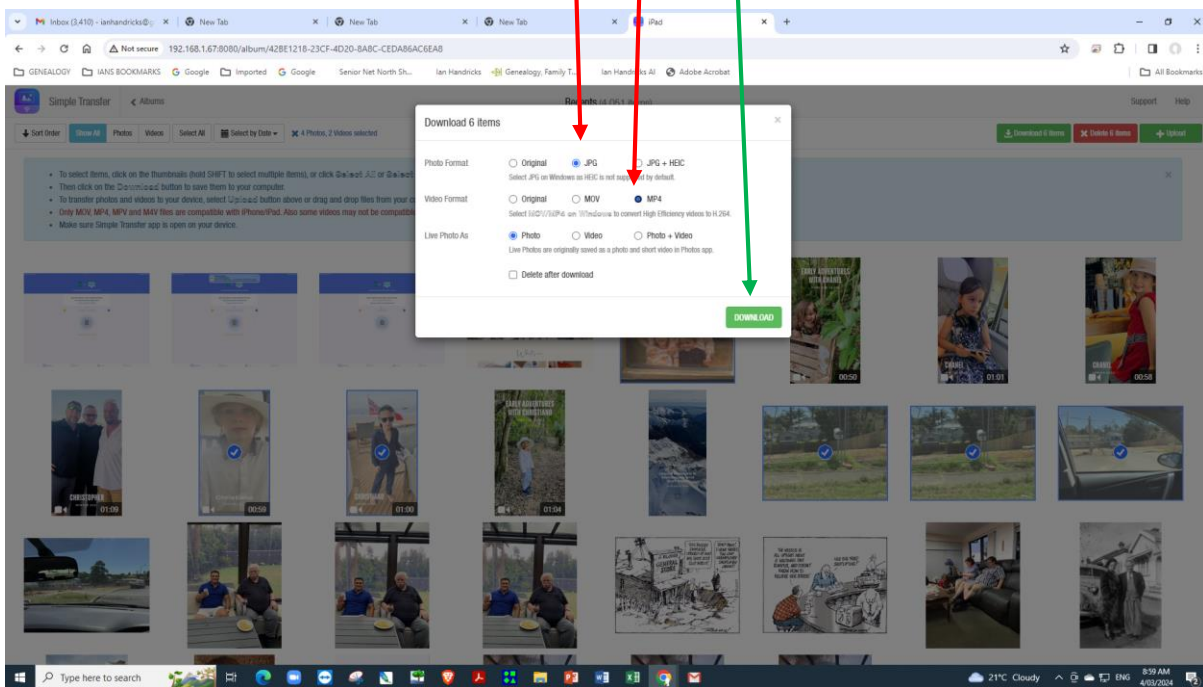
- When all photos are chosen – click on the green “DOWNLOAD x ITEMS” button (top right of screen)



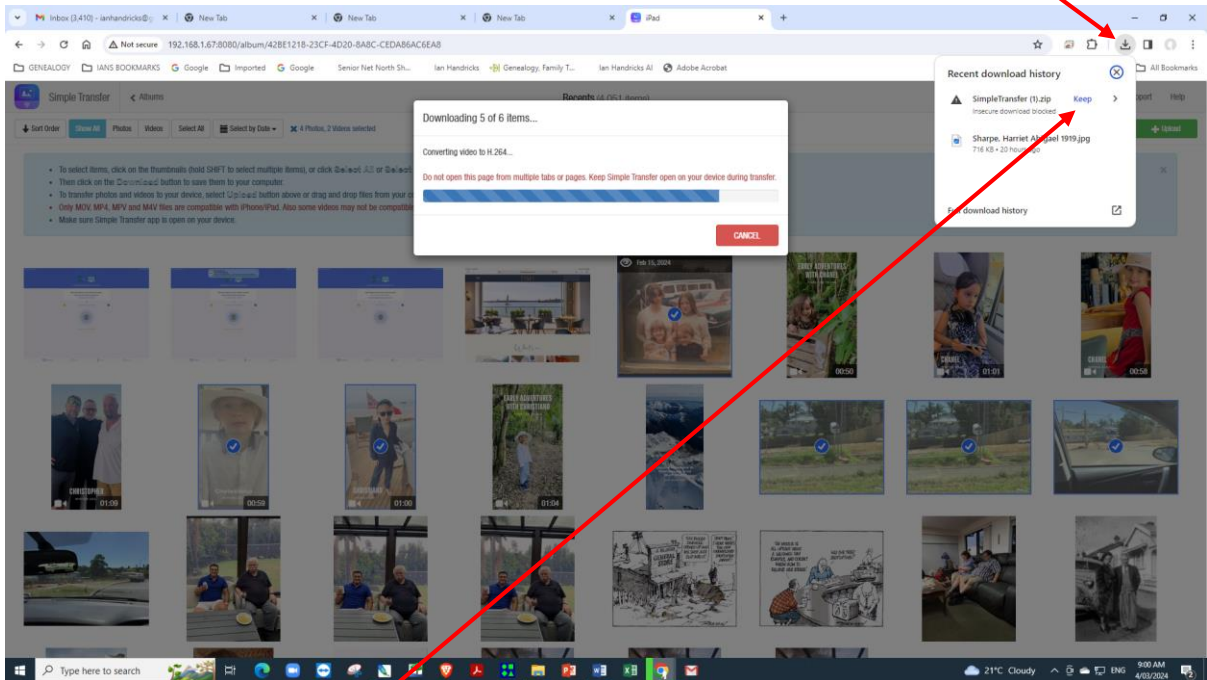
- A window will appear displaying formats



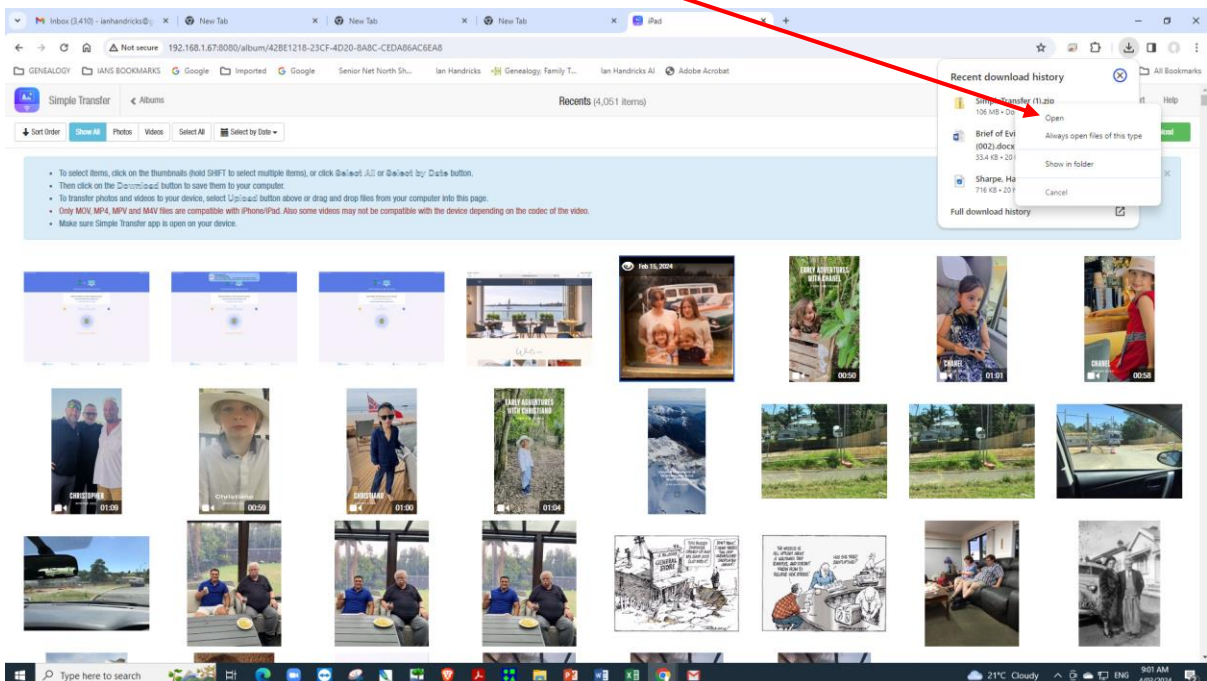
- Change Photo format to JPG
- Change Video format to MP4
- Click on green "DOWNLOAD" button



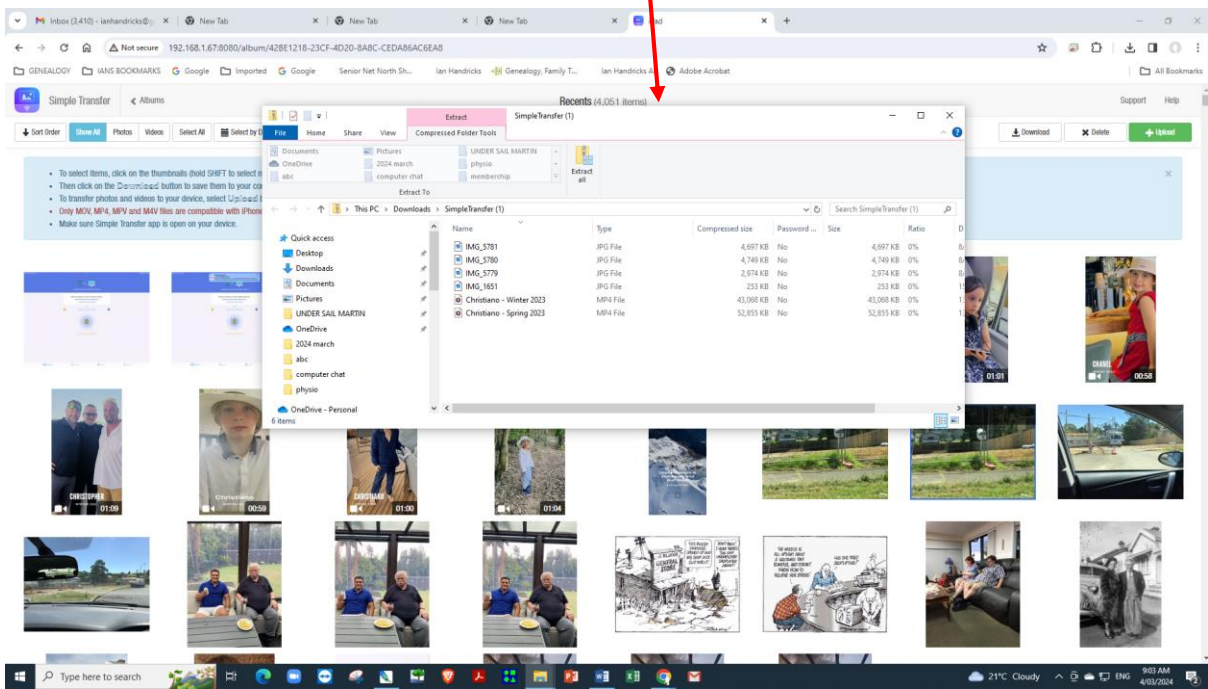
- The photos will be downloaded onto your computer from your phone to your “Downloads” folder on your PC. This can be seen by clicking on downloads icon on top right of screen.



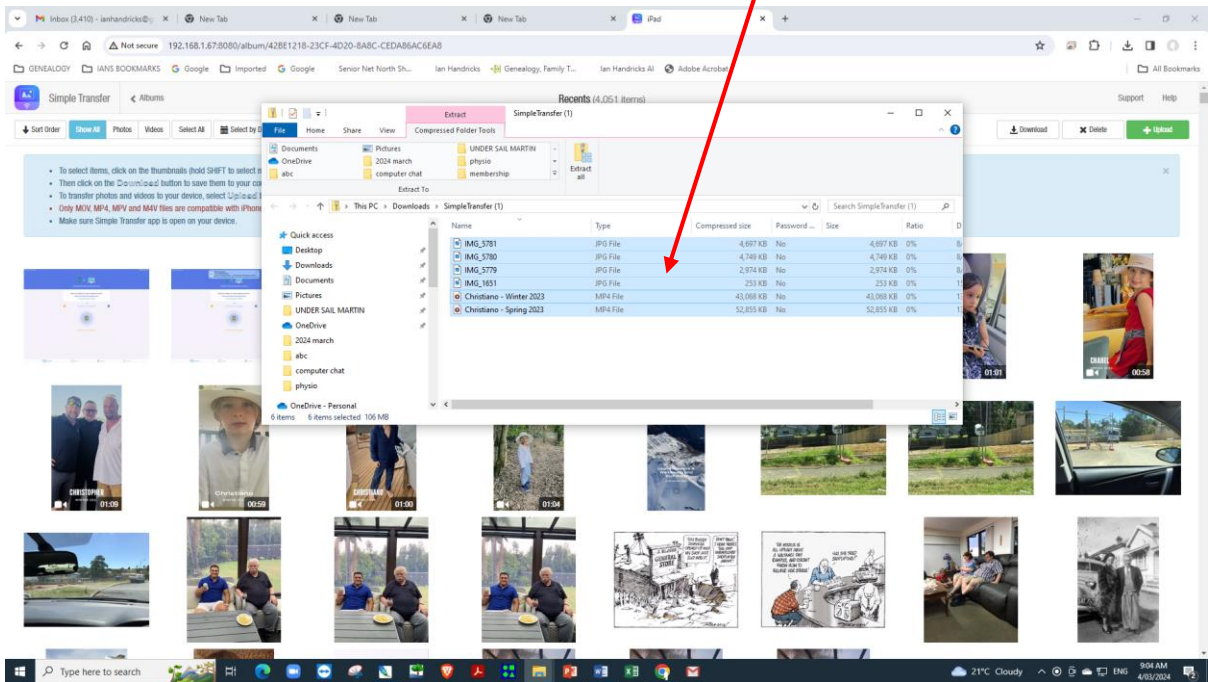
- Click on the word “Keep” next to the download file
- When download is complete - click on downloads icon on top right of screen and then RIGHT CLICK on the downloaded file
- Choose “OPEN”



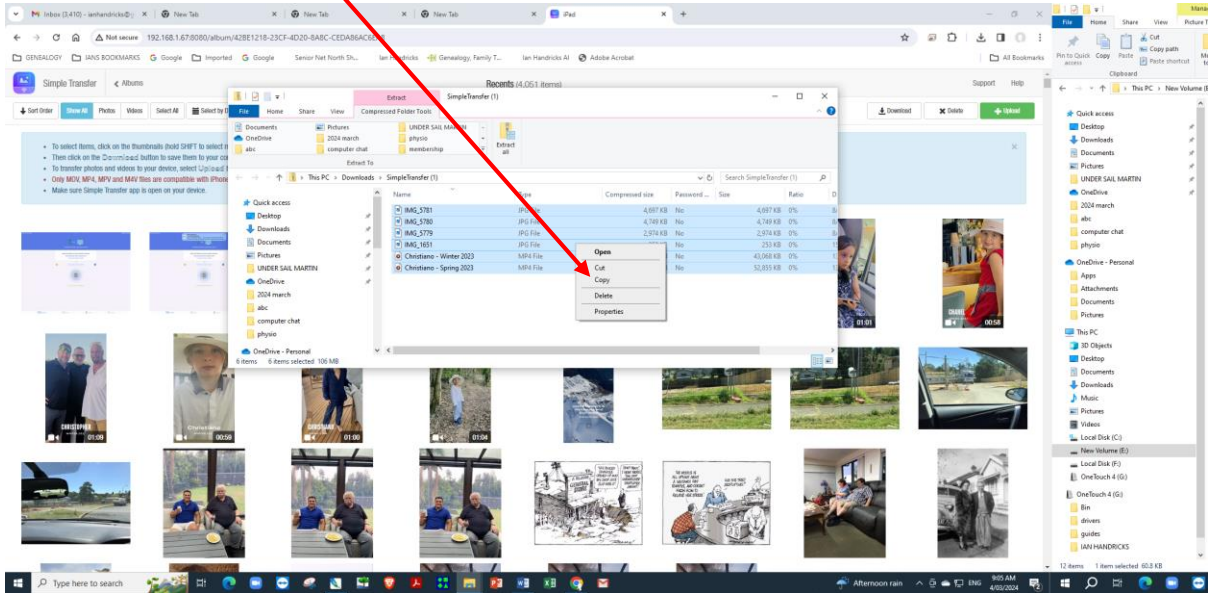
- A new window will appear showing all of the downloaded files



- Click "CONTROL A" to select all of those files (the background behind the files should turn blue)



- RIGHT CLICK on the files (in the blue area)
- Choose “COPY”



- Then go to your destination folder and paste (CONTROL V)

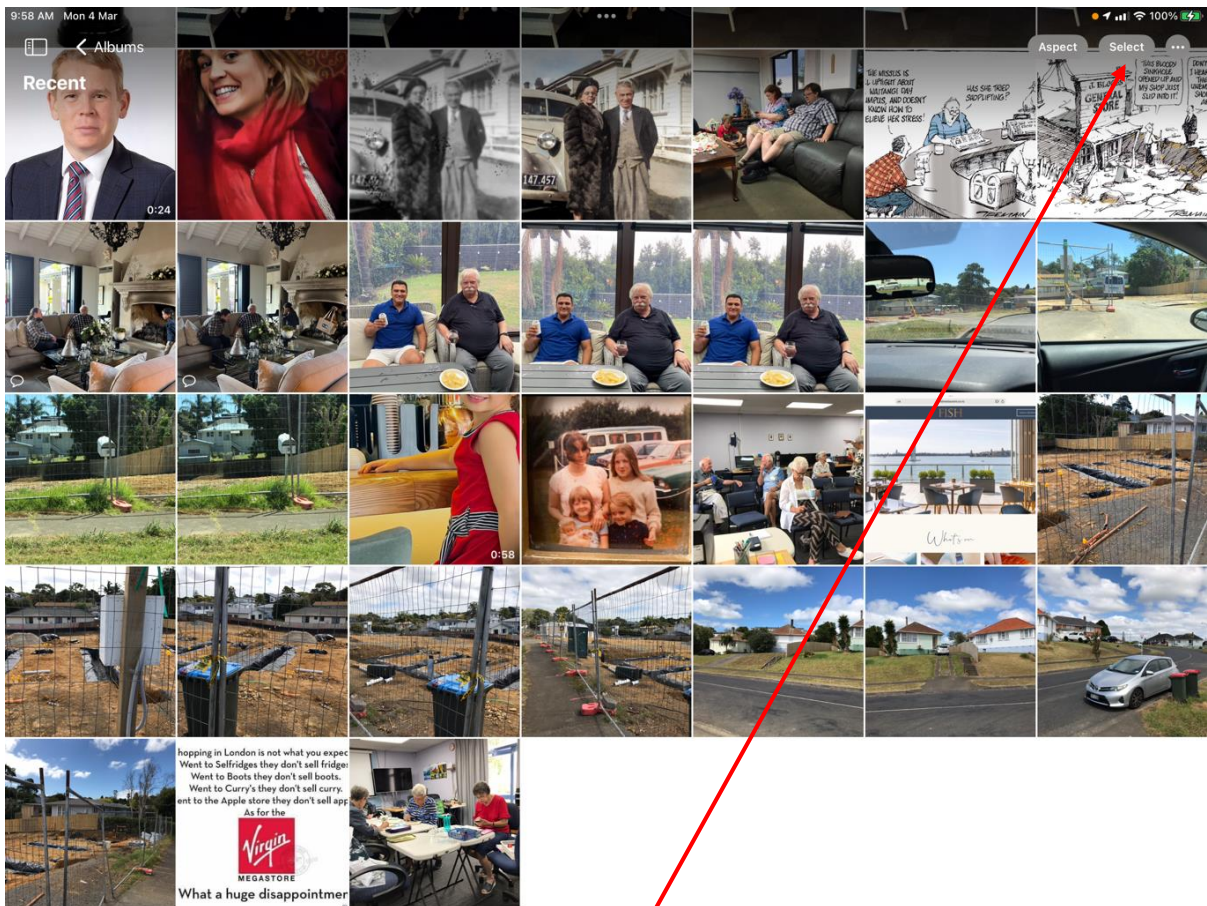

Method 2 (using email)

- On your phone or iPad choose the “GALLERY” app

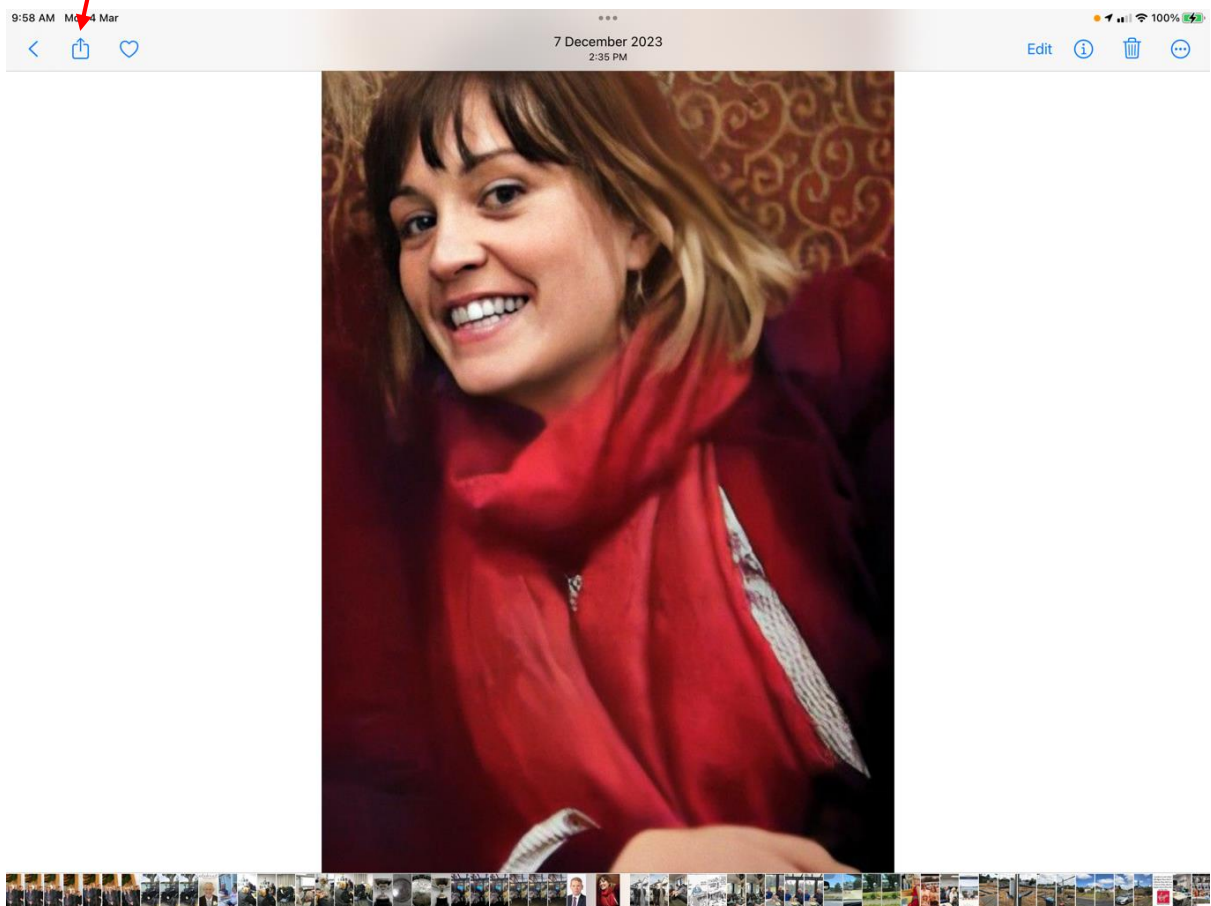
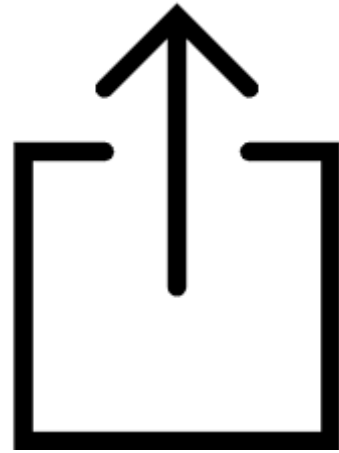


- Choose the “RECENTS” folder

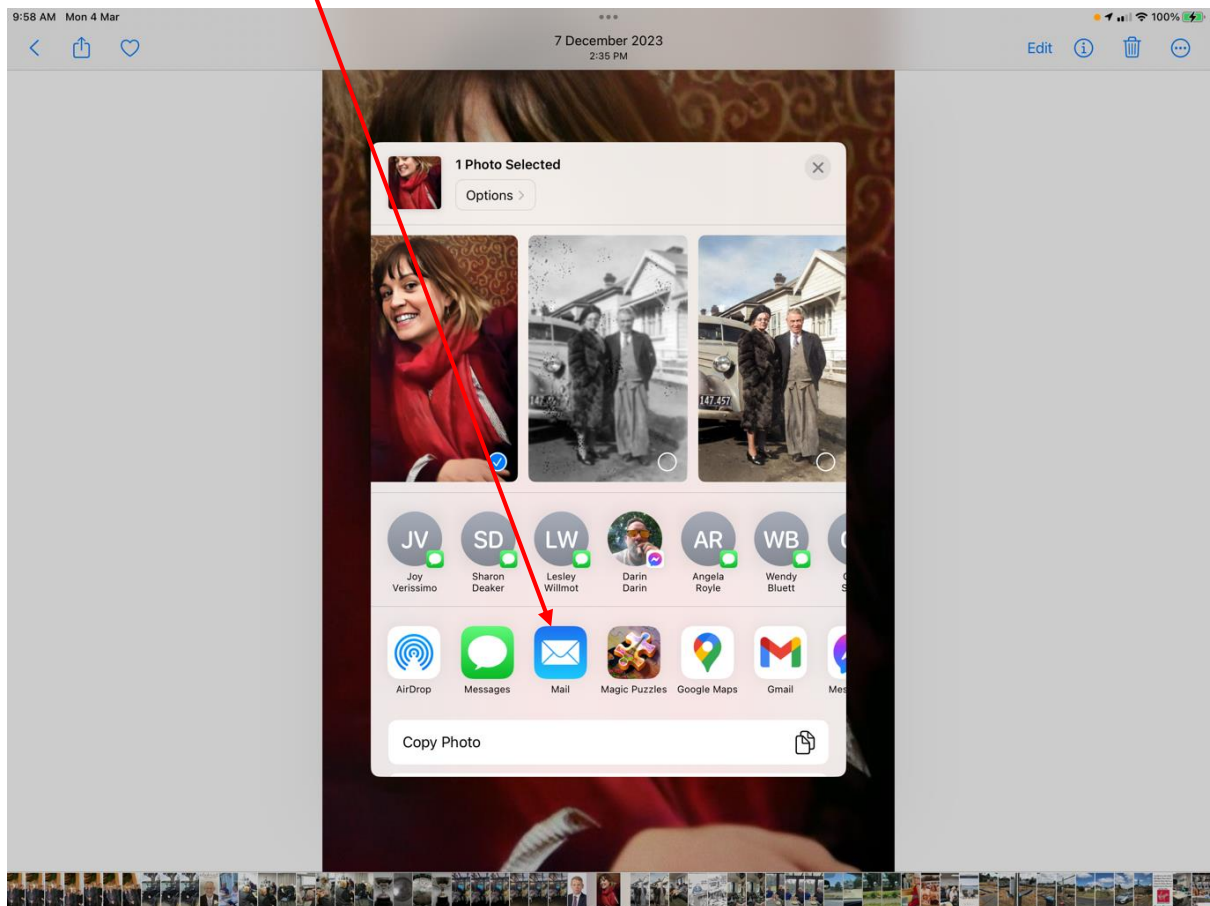


- Click on “SELECT” button at top right of screen
- Click on photos you wish to transfer

- Click on “UPLOAD” icon



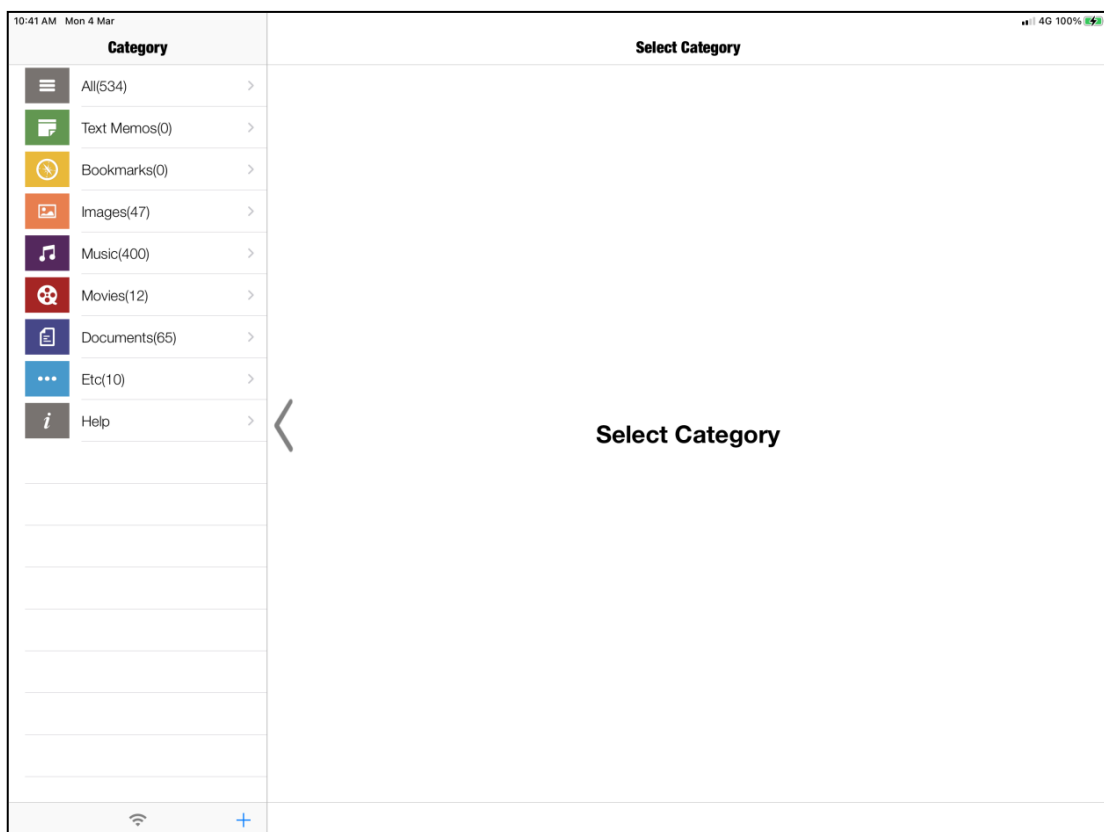
- Choose "MAIL"
- Enter email address and send



COMPUTER TO PHONE (OR IPAD)

Method 1 (using an app)

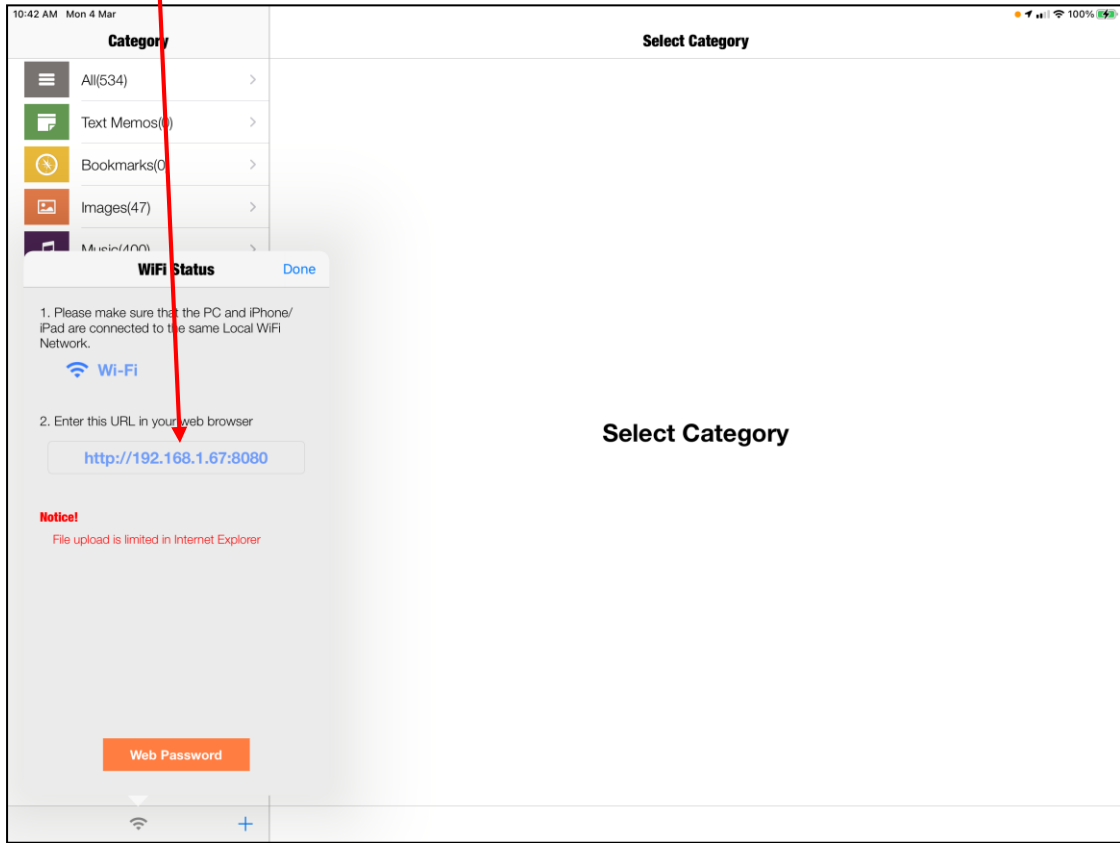
- Install “AIR TRANSFER +” app on your phone/iPad
(see <https://apps.apple.com/gb/app/air-transfer-file-transfer-from-to-pc-thru-wifi/id521595136>)
- Make sure that you are connected to the same router as your computer
([check your WI-FI connection in the settings app on your phone](#))
- On your phone (or iPad) launch the “AIR TRANSFER +” App



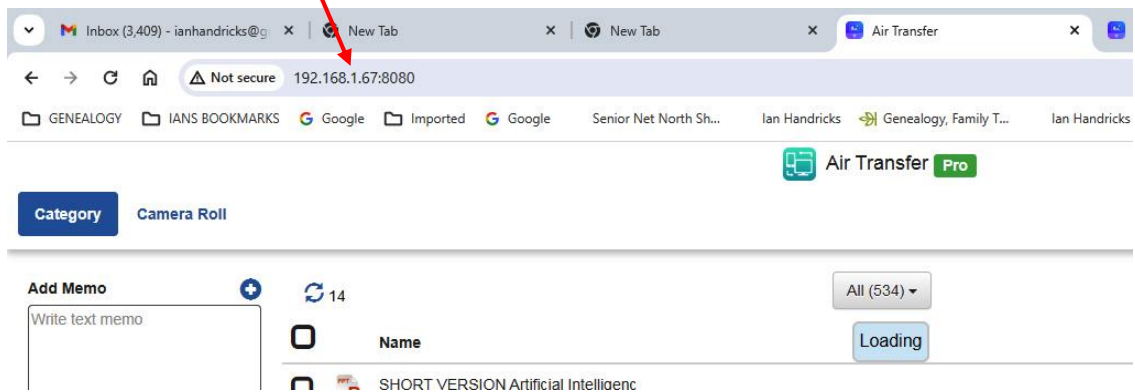
- Click on WIFI icon at bottom left of screen



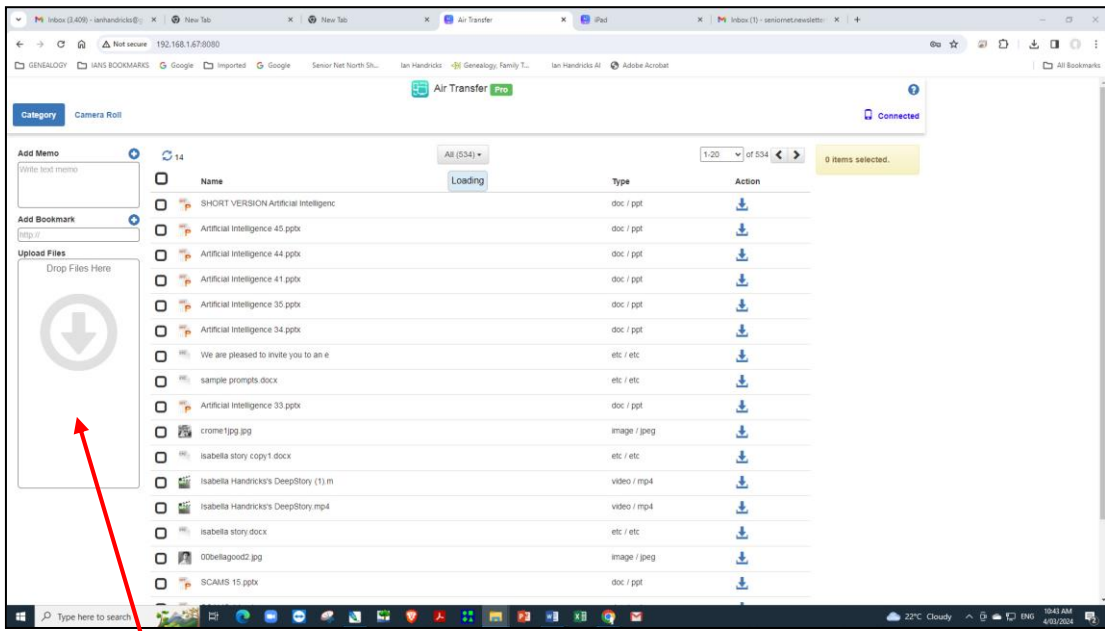
- Locate URL numbers (e.g. <http://192.168.1.67:8080>)



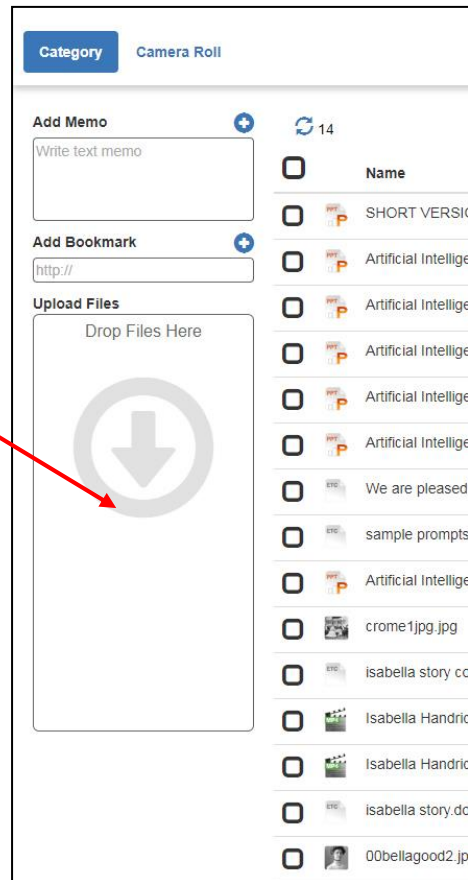
- Enter that number sequence (exactly) on your computer (or laptop) in the top URL line on your browser (e.g. Chrome) – make sure commas and colons are correct



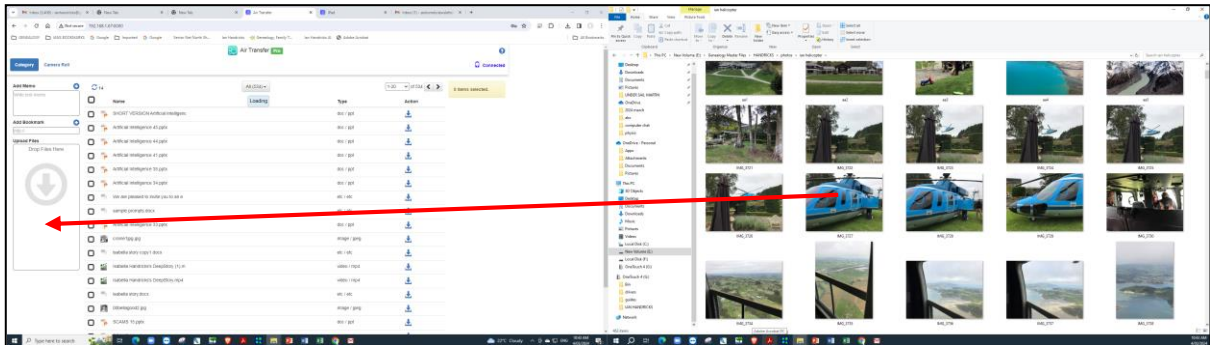
- The file transfer screen will appear on your PC



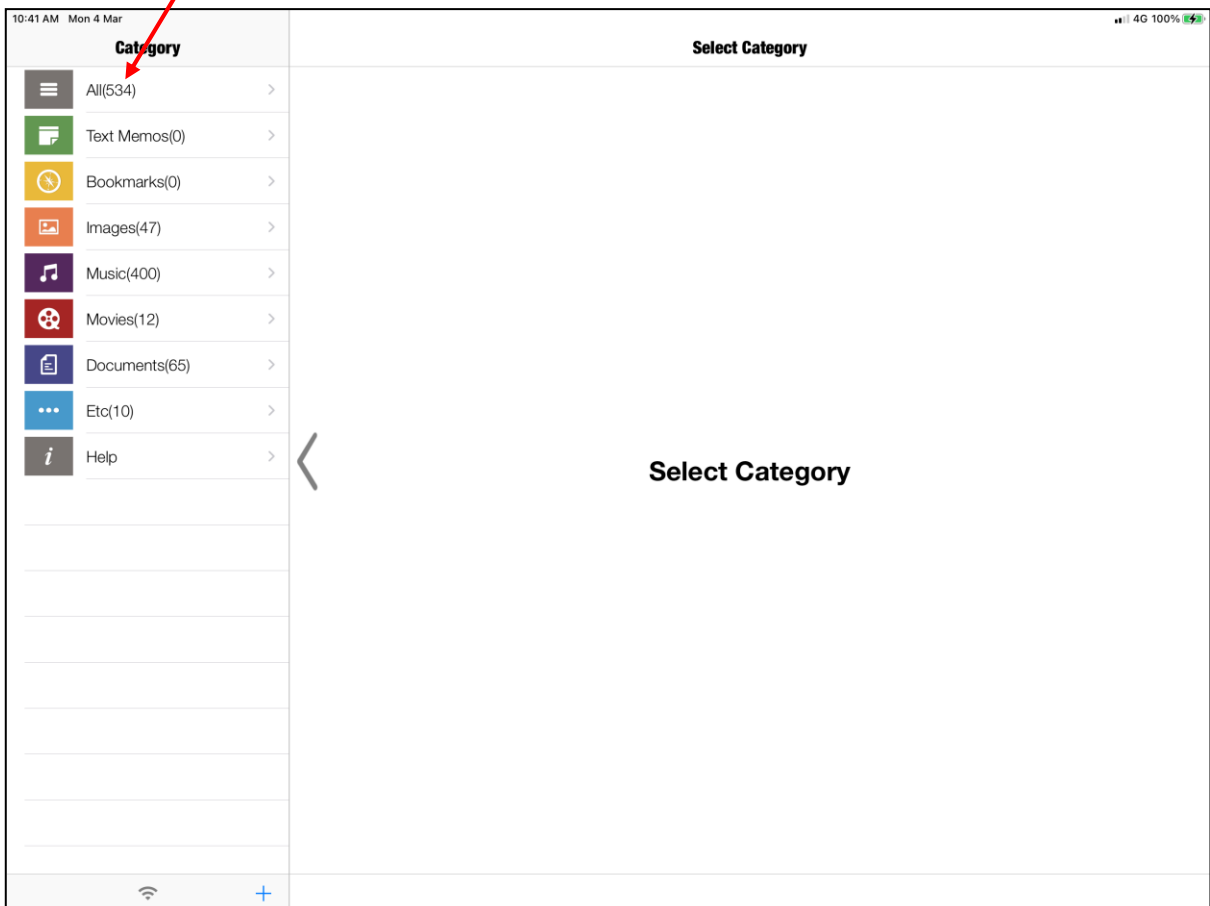
- Notice the box on the far left of the screen with a “DOWN ARROW IN A CIRCLE” – this is where you drag and drop files that you want to go to your phone or iPad (or you can click on this box and choose the files you want)



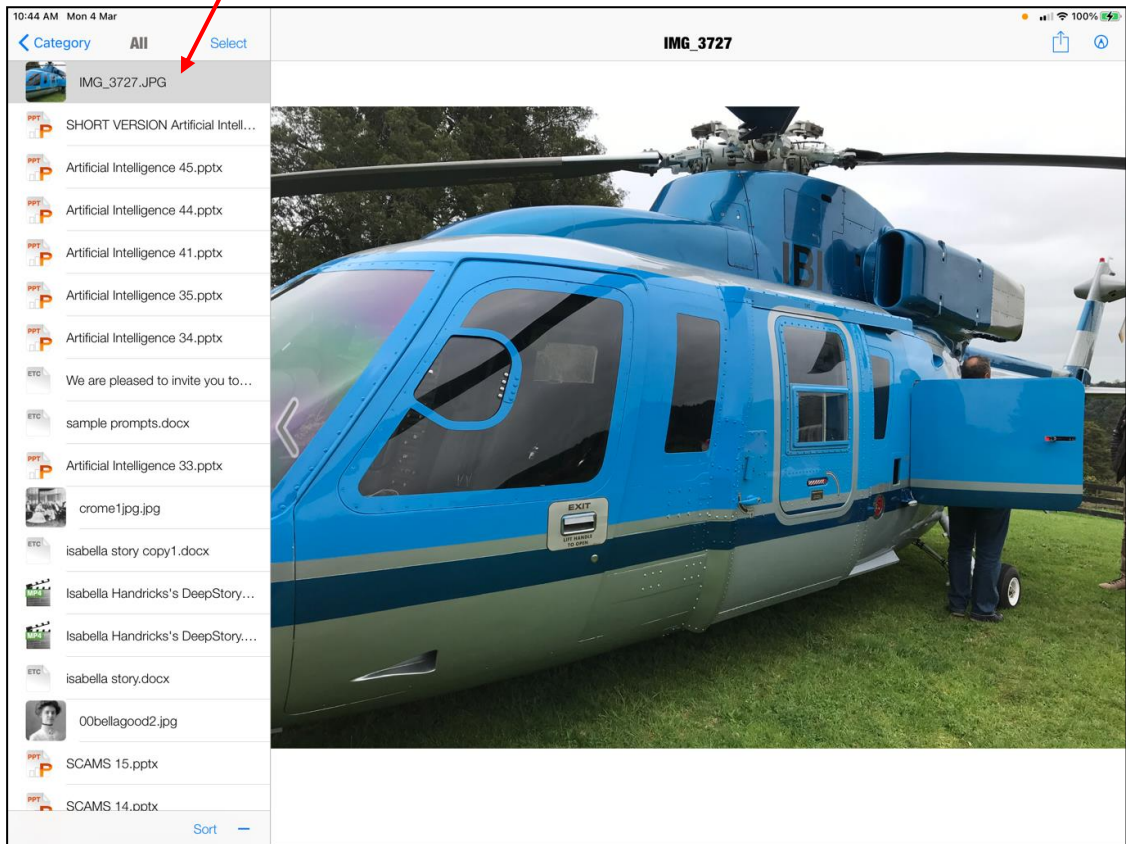
- Drag files from your PC (e.g. photos)



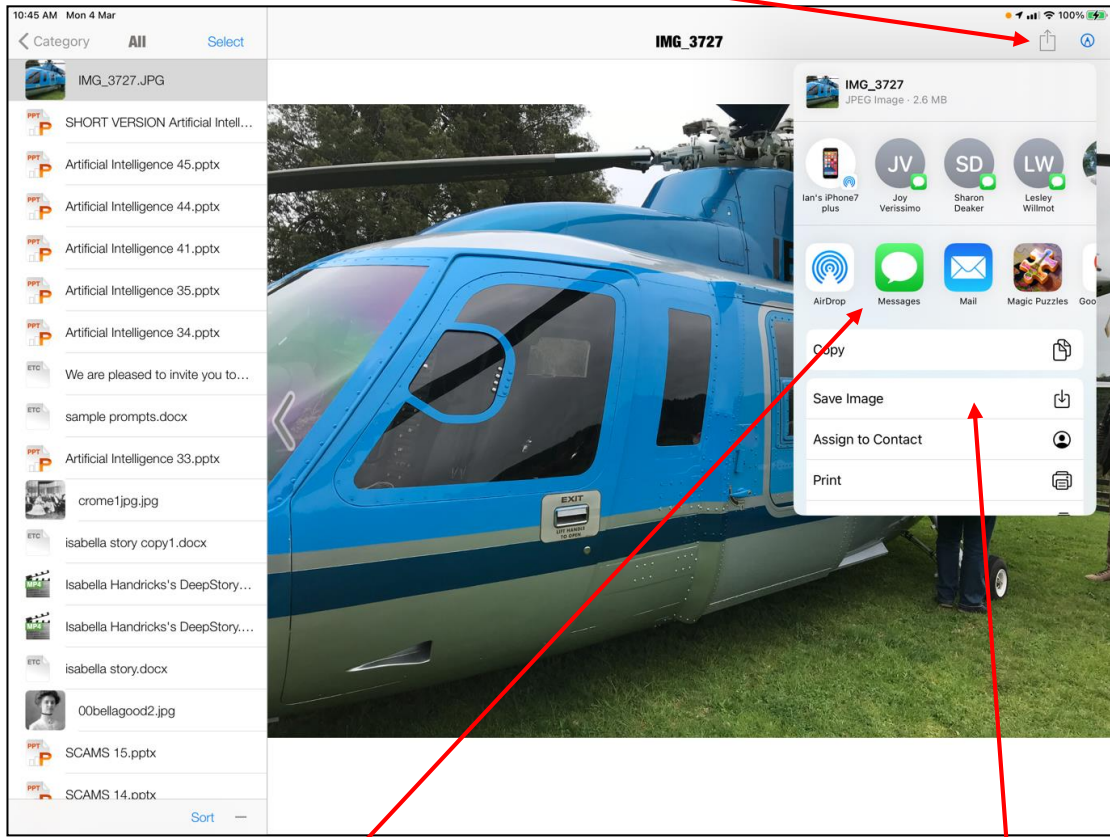
- These files will be copied to your phone or iPad
- Click on "ALL" to see uploaded files



- Click on particular uploaded file



- Click on “UPLOAD” icon



- Slide finger across 2nd row of icons to find destination app for your file or click on “Save Image” to save photo to your gallery on the phone or iPad
