The monthly schedule of tutorials and discussion groups is on our website and in the monthly newsletter. Our Tutors are members of the club and are volunteers.

Classes are held in our clubroom at the St John Ambulance Centre, 2 Shea Terrace, Takapuna. They run from 10.00am - 12.00 noon and from 1.00 pm - 3.00pm. The charges per session are: \$3.00 for a discussion group and \$5.00 for a tutorial. This includes refreshments.

Monthly meetings are held on the second Sunday of each month from 10.00am till noon in the hall at the St John Ambulance Centre, 2 Shea Terrace, Takapuna. Guest speakers talk on various subjects. Details are in the monthly newsletter.

You will see that we have extended the type of sessions we offer – for several reasons. One is that many of our members enjoy the camaraderie of other members as well as learning new skills. However, all have some computer related elements.

Annual membership (due 1 July each year) is \$35.00 per person or \$50.00 for two at the same address. Members joining in May pay a full subscription which continues until renewal 1 July the following year. From January until June of any year, the subscription is \$18.00 per person or \$25.00 for two people at the same address.

A name tag will be posted to you and you will receive the monthly newsletter by email. You can attend any session of your choice. Tutorials need to be booked by contacting the appropriate tutor whose details are listed on the schedule. It is not necessary to book for a discussion group, just come along.

NB: Please sign the attendance book on arrival. This is a safety requirement and will also ensure that any notes or items of interest from your class can be forwarded to you.

SeniorNet has three parking spaces near the entry door on the upper level. At times there are other spaces available but please discuss this with a tutor. Council have installed prepaid parking towers (\$1.00 per hour) in Shea Terrace, Mary Poynton Crescent and Northcote Roads. Payment is by cash or card at the "plate" machines installed. You input your registration number, choose a time and pay accordingly. Pay to park times are 8am to 6pm *Monday to Friday only*.

There is also a new AT Park app for iOS and Android smartphones making it easy to pay for on-street parking. You need to download the app, log in and log out when you return to your vehicle – you then pay for time used.
