The Wadham family has a rich history that spans several generations, with its roots tracing back to Jeremiah Wadham, born around 1750. Jeremiah married Elizabeth Rock, and together they had three children: William, born on December 29, 1777, in London; Sarah, born on July 17, 1785; and Thomas, born on August 14, 1787.

George Wadham, another child of William and Rose, was born on May 2, 1801, in Hospital, Endell St, Holborn, London. He married Hannah Beard in Exeter, Devon, England, on July 6, 1825. They had several children, including Elizabeth Hannah, George William, and Emma Mary.

William Wadham, the namesake of his father, was born on December 15, 1804, in Southwark, Surrey. He married Mary Priestman, and they had a large family, including Caroline Jane, Mary, Joseph, and Rose, among others.

Harriett Wadham, another of William and Rose's children, was born on January 15, 1814, in Southwark, Surrey. She married Timothy Manning on March 17, 1836, in Lambeth St John the Evangelist, England. They had a sizable family, with children like Mary Ann, William, James, and George.
